



**Maths**

We will learn about length and perimeter.  
Then multiplication and division, with a focus on 3, 6, 9 & 7 times tables.

**English - Reading**

We will use a variety of texts and our class reader 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' to focus on our vocabulary, retrieval and inference skills.

**English - Writing**

This term we will explore the texts 'Until I met Dudley' to write explanations and 'Mog's Christmas Calamity' to inspire narrative writing.

**Computing**

We will be checking, using and creating data through spreadsheets and databases.

**Geography**

We will be learning about the key physical and human features of the UK, focusing on map reading and how our cities and counties have changed over time.

**Art**

Painting cityscapes looking at foreground, background and proportion.

**PSHE**
